**Criteria and Selection Guidelines**

**Source of Expendable Funds**

**Purpose**

To provide financial assistance and incentive to 4<sup>th</sup> year engineering students in the Department of Electrical and Computing Engineering for excellence, innovation and originality of design established through proper analysis, prototyping and verification in their Capstone Project.

**Number and Amount of Awards**

The expendable funds will provide one annual award of \$10,000 that will be shared equally with the chosen Engineering Design Projects (EDP Capstone) members commencing in the 2013-14 academic year. The award will be made available to eligible students for a minimum of five years.

**Award Schedule**

First Award: to be presented in the 2013-14 academic year

Life of Award: five years

Application Deadline: No application required

Time of Offer: Fall of each year

**Eligibility & Application Information**

To be eligible for this award, students must:

- Be enrolled as a full-time graduate/undergraduate students in the Electrical and Computing Engineering program and have clear academic standing;
- Be a formal member of a group working on an EDP Capstone project.

**Selection and Administration**

The selection committee will be composed of at least three representatives from the Ryerson University Department of Electrical and Computing Science. They will review the student EDP capstone projects and prepare a ranked list of qualified submissions. They will make the final selection of the project based on the weighted criteria:

If in the opinion of the selection committee that no capstone project members and/or capstone projects meet the outlined criteria, the award shall not be given that year.
